Please add a new feature within the Filemanager module that automatically displays the Deployteq URL in the 'Details' of an uploaded image. This would make it easy to use when working solely with HTML templates.

Currently, the process is somewhat cumbersome, as you have to create an email first, then import images, and finally copy the URL of the image in Preview mode. This can certainly be made more efficient and user-friendly.

Unfortunately, this is currently not possible to implement. The files that are uploaded to the File Manager are not publicly available. The URL for an image is generated once the image is being inserted into a template, because only then the file is copied to the "public" part of the platform. However, it is possible to have a public SFTP folder in Deployteq and use that to host the images. That way, all public URL's have a predictable naming scheme.
