I would really like to see one of the following two fields in the broadcast fields:

`original_new_content_id` or `content_name`

Currently, you have the following fields:

I store these in the data model after submission using `store_in_datamodel`.

However, these two IDs are not useful—you can't search by them. Whereas I can use `original_new_content_id` in the URL to look up the email. Also, for readability, the content name would be very helpful.
